



Oly*Fun Geometric Pillow

SUPPLY LIST

Sizzix Bigz Die – 658881 Smalle Simple Wedge
Oly*Fun in Silver, Gold and Rose Gold
White Cotton fabric backing – 17" x 17"

Thread
Access to a sewing machine
16" pillow form
Plain clear tape

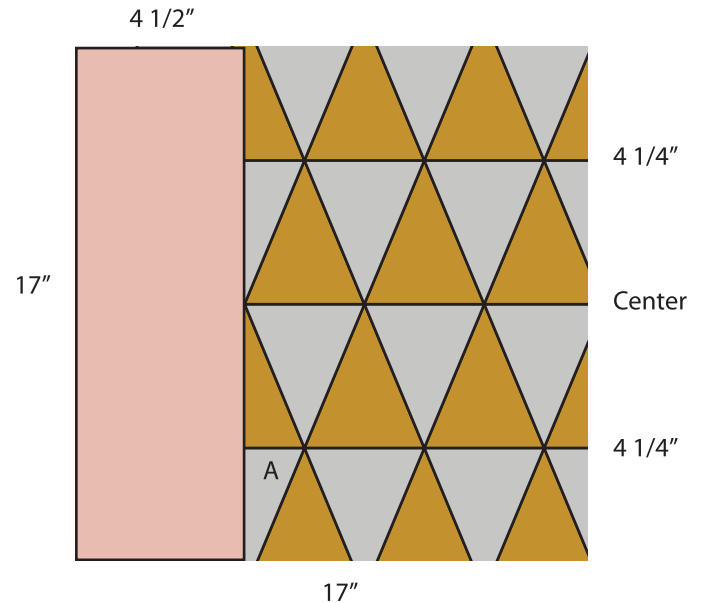
Die cut 14 triangles in Silver and 14 in Gold. Cut two of each color in half vertically {piece A in diagram}.

Cut Rose Gold rectangle 4 1/2" x 17".

Cut Rose Gold square {pillow back} 17" x 17".

Cut white cotton backing to 17" x 17".

Starting from the left side of the cotton fabric, measure 4 1/2" and draw a vertical line using a pencil. This will be the Rose Gold side panel. On the right side, find the center between the top and the bottom of the cotton fabric and draw a horizontal line. Measure 4 1/4" down and draw another horizontal line. Measure 4 1/4" up from the center and draw another horizontal line. These will guide your placement of the triangles.



Starting on the bottom row, align the first half silver triangle along the vertical and horizontal lines {piece A above}. Use clear tape to hold the piece in place. Do not use pins on the Oly*Fun because it will leave marks. Continue to align all triangles along the bottom row as shown.

Sew a straight line along the top edge of the row staying very close to the edge of the Oly*Fun. Repeat each horizontal row removing tape as you sew edges.



After all of the horizontal edges are secured, sew along the diagonal edges staying close to the edge of the Oly*Fun material.

After all triangles are sewn, align the Rose Gold vertical rectangle piece and sew it along the edge of the triangles on the left.

With right sides together, sew the front and back of the pillow together using a 1/2" seam and leaving the bottom open. Trim any extra seam allowance. Carefully turn the pillow right-side out trying not to wrinkle the Oly*Fun. Insert pillow form and hand-sew the bottom seam closed.
